



## **Sound Spaces Research Group – HEAR**

### **Artist Residency 2019/20 — Mulhouse and Strasbourg**

#### **Call for participation**

##### **THE PROJECT**

The Sound Spaces research group of the Haute école des arts du Rhin is publishing a call for application for residency for artists whose work involves sound as a significant element. Candidates must have finished their studies at least three years prior to the residency.

The selected artist will have the opportunity to work in two sites of the HEAR, in the cities of Mulhouse (November 2019) and Strasbourg (January 2020).

A lecture / presentation by the selected artist will be programmed at the beginning of the residency, in both cities. The school covers travel costs between Strasbourg and Mulhouse.

The resident artist will be able to work with students in the realisation of their project, and could also interact with students around their own projects.

During the Mulhouse period, the artist will propose an intervention with the students in connection with his/her residency project, the form of which will be defined in coordination with the teachers.

##### **AVAILABLE RESOURCES**

In Mulhouse : access to equipment throughout the school and the assistance of a qualified person. An apartment is provided (in the framework of a partnership with La Kunsthalle, centre of contemporary art in Mulhouse).

In Strasbourg : access to equipment in Phonon, a working space, the assistance of a qualified person, an apartment and, under certain conditions, possibility to use other technical means in the school (wood or glass workshop...)

Three return tickets will be provided for travel between the artist's home and Strasbourg / Mulhouse, one for each period of residency, and one for an initial visit to coordinate the

residency.

The artist will receive a grant of 3000 € net

### **EXPENSES REMAINING FOR THE ARTIST**

Production costs.

Meals will not be provided.

### **LENGTH/DATES**

The length of the residency is two months, split in two periods :

- One month in November 2019 ( Mulhouse)
- One month in January 2020 (Strasbourg)

### **THE APPLICATION SHOULD CONTAIN**

- a statement of intent presenting the research project to be considered for the residency
- CV
- Portfolio with visuals and possibly links to audio and video documents online.
